I apologize for the delay in responding to your letter of July 28, 2009. We've been working the issues regarding the golf course with some intensity for months now, with Fort Belvoir, Family Morale, Welfare & Recreation Command, the Corps of Engineers, and other government players. Although we don't have all the answers yet, I assure you that we would like to see the continuous retention of 36 playable holes. This means we would expect to see construction replacing any holes displaced by the Army Museum site.

We have not worked through all of the funding challenges, but we should have a more definitive plan within the next few months.
